1.0 Introduction

Adroit Law (We) use Necessary Cookies on our website www.adroit.law to ensure that it is working properly.

We also use Analytical Cookies to help us understand how you use our website. Additionally, we use Optical Functionality and Targeting Cookies to ensure that you get the best experience when using our website.

We have prepared this notice to inform you about your choices when you engage with our website and how to manage them.

What are cookies?

A cookie is a small piece of data that websites you visit ask your browser to store on your device so that they can remember some information about you, such as your preferences, device information and when you visit the website.

The information collected does not usually identify you directly. Still, it may contain details about your preferences to help you navigate the website in a more personalized way.

How Adroit Law uses cookies

We are committed to upholding your rights as a data subject, and we let you choose the type of cookies you wish to allow. However, blocking some types of cookies may affect your overall experience while using our website and the services you can access.

Strictly necessary cookies

These cookies are strictly necessary to provide you with the information you have specifically requested. They do not store any personal data, but we require them to run our website and for you to use its features. Because of this, they cannot be switched off from our systems. However, you can set your browser to block or alert you about these cookies, but when you do, some parts of our website will not work.

Our website uses these cookies on a legitimate interest basis to ensure that our website has proper technical functionality and that you can access the services you have expressly requested.

Functional cookies

These are cookies that are used to remember your choices. They include changes you

may have made to customize and improve your user experience, such as language choice and changes to the text size. These are optional cookies. However, if you choose to disallow these cookies, then some or all of these services may not function as you wish.

Analytical cookies

We or third-party service providers may set these cookies to collect information on how you use our website. The information collected may include, for instance, which pages our visitors visit more often and how they get to access our website. We only collect such information to improve how our website works. These cookies are optional, and the information collected is usually anonymous. If you do not allow these cookies, we will not know whether you have visited our website.

Targeting cookies

These cookies record that you have visited our website, as well as other pages you may have visited and links you may have followed to access our website. We may use this information to better align the information we display on our website with your interests, including marketing information.

We collect the information to help us understand our visitors' interests and measure how effective our marketing efforts are. Sometimes, this information is shared with third parties, who remember the other websites you visit. These are optional cookies. If you do not allow these cookies, you are less likely to experience targeted marketing.

2.0 "Similar Technologies" means:

When used in relation to cookies, they include local objects such as web beacons, pixels, browser fingerprinting technologies or any technology that stores or accesses information on the user's device.

This information does not usually allow us to identify you, but it can improve your experience when visiting our website.

3.0 Changes to our Cookies Notice

We may change the details on our Cookies Notice from time to time. When we do make a significant change, we will notify you through a pop-up on the website just before and right after we make the changes. You may re-evaluate your cookie options and permissions after that.
